Welcome and Introductions

Kelly Henry welcomed the group and reviewed the mission of the PLC.

Old Business

- The group finalized the Summary of the Nov. 7, 2017 PLC Meeting. It will be posted to the website (ocguelph.com).
- Penny McInnis and Beverley Hale briefed the group on a recent conversation during which they discussed the ways that data is presented to the PLC. The result, thanks to Beverley, is a clearer way to communicate information, particularly when using graphs.

Plant Update

- Rob Nixon gave an update on:
 - o Owens Corning plant operations, including:
 - Generator replacement
 - Regenerative Thermal Oxidizer (RTO) trial
 - Health & Safety
 - Megan Moore, Owens Corning's Environmental, Health and Safety Leader, was introduced
 - Community
 - The plant is re-roofing sections of the facility, removing out-of-date equipment from roofs, and conducting general cleanup activities.
 - Symposium action plan
 - After an April 11-12, 2017 symposium, a report was drafted and submitted to the Ministry outlining technical findings and identifying action items. The symposium brought together 18 specialists, including engineers, scientists, suppliers and representatives from the MOECC.
 - All action items identified in the report are either completed or near completion.

Air Monitoring Program

- Penny McInnis reviewed data results in the draft Ambient Monitoring Report for fourth quarter, 2017.
- The PLC was given an update on the anticipated 2017 Annual Ambient Air Monitoring Report.
- The 2017 Annual Ambient Air Monitoring Report will be submitted to the Ministry in May 2018 after it is reviewed with the PLC at the next meeting.
